

**ORDINANCE NO. 10-2013**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE SPECIFICATIONS, ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND AWARD CONTRACTS RELATED TO THE PORTAGE RIVER ELECTRICAL LINE CROSSING**

**WHEREAS**, it has been reported to the Council of the Village of Oak Harbor that the electrical line which currently supplies electricity to customers of the Oak Harbor Utilities on the south side of the Portage River is in a state of disrepair; and

**WHEREAS**, failure to address the problems with the electrical line will cause further loss of service and other electrical problems for customers on the south side of the Portage River; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council has determined that the above project is necessary to maintain the health, safety and general welfare of the customers of Oak Harbor Electrical System and specifically, the customers south of the Portage River.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:**

**Section 1.**

That the Council of the Village of Oak Harbor, Ottawa County, Ohio, hereby authorizes the Village Administrator to prepare specifications, advertise for bids for the Portage River Electrical Line Crossing project, and award contracts on the project to the lowest and/or best bidder and execute all documents necessary to accomplish this project.

**Section 2.**

This Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council, and of its committees, which result in formal action, were taken in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements.

**Section 3.**

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect and after the earliest date allowed by law.
