

RESOLUTION NO. 01-2010

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE COMMUNITY MESSAGE BOARD PROJECT FOR THE ADOLPHUS KRAEMER PARK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Zack Seaman has indicated that he would like, as his Boy Scout Eagle project, to construct and erect a community message board, to be located in the Adolphus Kraemer Park, for the village use; and

**WHEREAS**, the project has been presented to Village Council and Council has indicated interest and support for the project and has referred the project to Council's Parks Committee and the Board of Architectural Review for approval; and

**WHEREAS**, Council has been advised that as the project design anticipates the use of recycled plastic content and that the project may qualify for an Ottawa Sandusky County Joint Solid Waste Management District grant and all applications for grant funds must be accompanied by a Resolution of Support from the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ottawa Sandusky County Joint Solid Waste Management District deadline for grant applications is January 31, 2010, and therefore this Resolution in Support of the Community Message Board Project is an emergency measure, necessary to meet the time limitations of the Ottawa Sandusky County Joint Solid Waste Management District and provide for the general health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village, and shall therefore be effective immediately upon its adoption and due authentication by the Mayor and Fiscal Officer, respectively; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:**


**Section 1.** That the Village Council of the Village of Oak Harbor is in support of the Community Message Board Project for Adolphus Kraemer Park proposed by Mr. Zack Seaman.

**Section 2.** That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 3.** This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure, and as such, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and due authentication by the Mayor and Fiscal Officer, respectively.
