

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-2010**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO SPONSOR THE OAK HARBOR AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE ANNIVERSARY T-SHIRT DESIGN CONTEST, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Council has determined that the payment of Two Hundred Dollars to the Oak Harbor Area Chamber of Commerce in order to become a sponsor of the Oak Harbor Village 175<sup>th</sup> anniversary T-Shirt Design contest would be a valid public purpose; and


**WHEREAS**, the deadline for sponsorships being March 22, 2010, Council has determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure, necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the Village, and as such shall take effect immediately upon adoption and due authentication by the Mayor and Fiscal Officer, respectively.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF OAK HARBOR, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO:**


**Section 1.** That the Village of Oak Harbor, Ohio, shall contribute the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, (\$200.00), from the General Fund to the Oak Harbor Area Chamber of Commerce for the purpose of becoming a sponsor of the Oak Harbor Village 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary T-Shirt Design Contest.

**Section 2.** That all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council; and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Revised Code.

**Section 3.** That this Resolution authorizing the payment of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to the Oak Harbor Area Chamber of Commerce, for the reason stated in the preamble hereto is an emergency measure, and as such shall be immediately effective following adoption and due authentication by the Mayor and Fiscal Officer, respectively.
