

PARKS COMMITTEE MEETING
June 15, 2007
3:00 P.M.

Chairman Angela Petersen called the meeting to order at Veterans' Park.

The following members answered roll call: Chairman Angela Petersen and Beverly Goldstein.

Also in attendance were Administrator John Liske and Superintendent Randy Genzman. Both were asked to be present for said meeting.

SLEDDING HILL

All attendees inspected the hill and the surrounding area. After discussing the previous ideas, i.e. padding around trees, removal of trees, straw bales, signage and fences, the committee agreed to do the following:

1. Remove the tree located on the northwest side of the hill, located approximately 12 feet from the base of the hill.
2. Hang signs on both utility poles and on the connecting wire, located on the south side of the hill, stating "Do not sled or ride this direction."


SIDEWALK

All attendees surveyed the park from where the sidewalk will enter from the Dold Subdivision to Finke Road. The committee mapped out a route that curved behind the south baseball diamond stands, with slight curves around trees and a storm drain, ending at Finke Street across from the north sidewalk on Main Street. The sidewalk would be approximately 600 feet with 1 ramp. The sidewalk would be 6 inches deep and 84 inches wide. Mr. Genzman estimated the cost, including labor, at \$51,000.00. The committee also agreed that low level/low intensity lights should be installed, if possible financially, for safety. Mr. Liske estimated the cost at \$21,000.00, if a smaller version of our downtown lights are purchased. Mr. Liske also mentioned that if lights are installed, we will need to amend our park rules accordingly. Mr. Liske and Mr. Genzman stated that there is a Safe Route to School Grant available and that CDBG monies can also be used toward this project.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned by Chairman Angela Petersen.
