

**BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS
PUBLIC HEARING

The following members were present: Donna Wendt-Elliott, Scott Gluth, Mayor Conley and Chairman Jim Smith. Anne Risch was absent


Also in attendance was: Robert Pauley, Village Administrator/Zoning Administrator, Cindy Garber, Secretary to the BZA, Pastor David Ritchie, (Representing St. Boniface Church) and Mr. Kevin Hesselbart.

The purpose of the hearing was to obtain public comment on a Conditional Use permit application for the expansion of a parking lot in an R3 Residential District requested by St. Boniface Church, 210 W. Ottawa St.

Mr. Kevin Hesselbart, who lives at 208 W. Ottawa St, had some concerns. One being snow removal. On the east side of his property, owned by St. John's Church, in the pas, he has had piles of snow as high as 3 feet tall up against his property. He is questioning where they plan to pile the snow. His other concern is the possibility of his foundation or garage being hit and wondered if some sort of barrier could be put up to avoid this from happening. His garage and the west side of his property will be very close to the parking lot.

Father Ritchie said that now that the church has the deed to the property an official survey will be done. It appears that one property or the other may be encroaching on the other. The snow will be removed and taken to the playground behind the school, which should resolve that issue.

No further Public Comment, Donna Wendt-Elliott made a motion to close the Public Hearing and Scott Gluth seconded the motion. All were in favor of said motion. Public Hearing was closed at 7:44 P.M.
